

NMU Student & Guests Dining Responsibilities Regarding Prevention

- a. KNOW THE SYMPTOMS: FEVER, COUGH & SHORTNESS OF BREATH. Symptoms may appear in 2 to 14 days.
- b. Know how it spreads: The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person. Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet). Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.
- c. Utilize the "GET Mobile APP" for fast pick up ordering, DO NOT CONGREGATE IN THE LOBBY, ENTRANCES, STATIONS, ETC. AND GIVE FELLOW GUESTS THEIR 6 FEET SPACE.
- d. Do not enter any dining facility or dining outlet if you have one COVID-19 symptom. Use NMU Dining Sick Tray Policy! Do not come to any dining facility or outlet. Stay in your dorm room & follow NMU's COVID-Preparedness & Response Plan on what to do if you are experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms or if you have been around someone who is. - e. If your suite-mate, friend, classmate, guest, etc. are sick tell them to use our Sick Tray Meal options.
- f. Wash your hands with soap and water and/or use hand sanitizer once entering any NMU Dining facility or outlet.
- g. Cover nose and mouth when coughing and sneezing with a tissue or napkin (or an elbow or shoulder if no tissue is available), then immediately dispose of the tissue or napkin and properly wash hands.
- h. Read guidelines for: proper hand washing, and staying home/in dorm room when sick.
- i. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands. If do you rewash them.
- j. Avoid sharing cups, eating utensils, and dishes with anyone. Avoid sharing phones, writing instruments, computers, any other personal items and if you do properly wash your hands or use hand sanitizer.
- k. Do not bring in reusable mugs, cups, etc. for refills. This includes the NMU Reusable Mug and water bottles, etc.
- l. Follow social distancing of 6 feet, properly wear a facemask at all times unless at your table and eating.
- m. Know you can help us by wiping down tables/chairs with the Purell Wipes located throughout the Dining Facility if eating inside the NLD, Melted or the Wildcat Den.
